### RESOLUTION NO. 530

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, LEVYING UPON THE ASSESSED VALUATION OF PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015-16 TO BE ASSESSED AGAINST THE VALUATION OF REAL PROPERTY FOR PRIMARY TAX PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the Town Council is required by A.R.S. §42-17253 to adopt an annual tax levy based upon the rate to be assessed per each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of valuation of property within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town published a summary of an estimate of Town expenses and made available for public review a complete copy of the estimate of Town expenses as required by A.R.S. § 42-17103; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed budget and tax levy was held on July 28, 2015, in accordance with the provisions of A.R.S. §42-17104; and

WHEREAS, the primary tax levy must be adopted not less than fourteen days after the adoption of the municipal budget; and

WHEREAS, the municipal budget of the Town of Jerome was adopted at a meeting of the Town Council held on July 28, 2015, at least fourteen days prior to the adoption of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Town has computed tax rates per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of valuation to be levied and collected, at \$0.8950 for primary taxes, as set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, as follows:

**Section 1.** That there is hereby levied on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed value of all property, both real and personal, within the corporate limits of the Town, except such property as may be by law exempt from taxation, a primary property tax rate sufficient to raise the sum of \$47,500.00, as provided in the adopted budget for the fiscal year ending on June 30, 2016 (with the maximum levy allowed by law for the fiscal year being \$81,545), and as set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto.

**Section 2.** Any failure by the Yavapai County officials to properly return the delinquent tax list, irregularity in assessments or omissions in the same, or any irregularity in any proceedings shall not invalidate such proceedings nor invalidate any title conveyed by any tax deed, any sale or proceeding pursuant thereto, the validity of the assessment or levy of taxes, nor the judgment of sale by which the collection of taxes may be enforced. All actions by officers *de facto* shall be valid as if performed by officers *de jure*.
