ITEM #10: **NEW BUSINESS** 8:33(38:45) ITEM #10A: TOUR BUSINESS LICENSE - JEROME HISTORY TOURS Joe Westcott will present a request for a tour business license for Jerome History Tours, a walking tour. Ms. Gallagher explained that Jerome History Tours had been given a business license last year by mistake, and we noticed that this year. Tour businesses are required to obtain approval from Council. At this time, we are assisting Mr. Westcott to become compliant. Joe Westcott approached the dais and explained his business plan and showed the Council his tour map. He explained that he does not have a storefront but works out of his residence in the Industrial zone. (39:52) Sage Harvey, Councilmember-elect, noted that, when she and her husband ran a similar tour company a few years ago, its business name was "Jerome History Walks." Ms. Gallagher explained that our Code dictates that tour businesses operate out of a premise in the C1 zone. He is operating out of the Industrial zone, but it's permitted uses are identical to those of the Commercial zone. The Code also requires that the tour route be approved by Council and that a certificate of insurance be provided to the Town. (46:19) Jane Moore, a Jerome resident, spoke about the issue being parking, and cautioned Council about setting a precedent. Council agreed that operating out of the Industrial zone is acceptable, since its permitted uses are the same as the C-1 zone. Ms. Gallagher suggested that the tour business ordinance be amended to specifically permit operating out of the Industrial zone. Council also noted that a Certificate of Insurance would be required.
